Entry Requirements

- Successful graduates of the LSBM/Edexcel Diploma in Information Technology programme or;
- Students who have a local or international qualification that is deemed by LSBM to be of a similar level to the LSBM/Edexcel Diploma in Information Technology programme.
- For students whose first language is not English, a minimum IELTS score of 5.0 or equivalent is required.

Academic Progression

This programme is equivalent to the second year of a British Bachelor's degree, and successful graduates are eligible to remain at LSBM and enter the Bachelor of Science (Honours) in Business Information Technology top up degree, which is awarded by the University of Wales. This programme is equivalent to the Higher National Diploma (HND) in Information Technology, which is awarded by Edexcel.

Graduates enhance their employability with in-demand IT skills and a good understanding of project management methods and techniques.
